

Determination of Nonsignificance

Description of proposal: Public Utility District No.1 of Douglas County proposes to install shoreline and rock tree root stabilization materials within Columbia Cove, Brewster, WA. The shoreline and root stabilization materials will consist of precast concrete panels, geotextile fabric, riprap, and crushed surfacing materials. All materials will be installed above the ordinary high water mark. All work will be done above the ordinary high water mark as well.

Proponent: Public Utility District No. 1 of Douglas County

Location of Proposal, including street address, if any:

The subject property is located within the City limits of Brewster, WA, and is commonly referred to as Columbia Cove. The subject area is listed as Okanogan County parcel numbers 3024140064 and 3024140122. The subject location is further found in Section 14, Township 30 North, Range 24 EWM.

There is no comment period for the DNS.


This DNS is issued under 197-11-340(2); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 15 days from the date below. Comments must be submitted by May 12th, 2017.
