To be eligible for energy assistance two qualifications must be met:

1: The customer's total household income, from all sources (including that of spouse or co-tenant), shall be 200% or less of the current Federal Poverty Level Guidelines. AND

2: The customer has an energy burden of 6% or more of their income. Energy burden is calculated by dividing your annual cost of power by your annual income. You can check your Smarthub account for your annual usage or call us. We will calculate your energy burden by the supplied income below.

Qualified customers will receive a one-time \$50 bill credit in 2022, monthly \$10 bill credits in 2023 on one active Douglas PUD account and potential future conservation measures. Applicants will be notified of award status via email.
