

Proposed Electric Rate Adjustments

Resolution 19-146 established a rate hearing for proposed rate adjustments. RCW 54.24.080 allows public utility districts to establish rates. A 3% rate adjustment is proposed for certain Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 rates. In addition, Schedule 1 would be amended to include new rates for the industries below.

Proposed 2020 Pole Attachment

Resolution 19-146 established a rate hearing for proposed rate adjustments. The District's rate formulation complies with RCW 54.04.045, which allows public utility districts to set rates charged to other entities for attachment of their wire, cable, or other communication equipment to poles owned by the District. The law further states that rates must be just, reasonable, nondiscriminatory and sufficient.

The current pole attachment rate of \$18.44 has not been adjusted since January 2015. Based on a review of the District's 12-month financial information ending October 31, 2019, the calculated rate per attachment is \$22.45.
